ALL PAYMENTS ARE DUE AND PAYABLE TO THE "TOWN OF PARIS" UPON SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

1. M.R.S.A. Title 23 § 3360-A, Protection of Underground Facilities (a.k.a. "The Dig Safe Law") which requires notifications to various entities at least three working days prior to making any excavation.
2. Proper signage and traffic control must be used to the satisfaction of the Road Commissioner or their authorized representative.
3. Prior to back filling, the Highway Director/Road Commissioner will be notified.
4. All back fill will be of appropriate material and compacted in 12" layers/lifts.
5. All excavations will be properly and completely repaired in 7 working days from time of back filling.
6. Applicant is responsible for excavation for a period of three (3) years.
7. **No permits shall be issued from November 1st of each year to April 15th of the following year.**

NOTICE TO APPLICANT

The applicant further agrees that, upon approval and issuance of a permit, the Road Commissioner will be notified at least 48 hours in advance of the start of any work. The applicant understands that the opening will be measured by the Road Commissioner or their representative. The applicant agrees to pay any subsequent charges on the differences between those estimated and the accurate measurements.

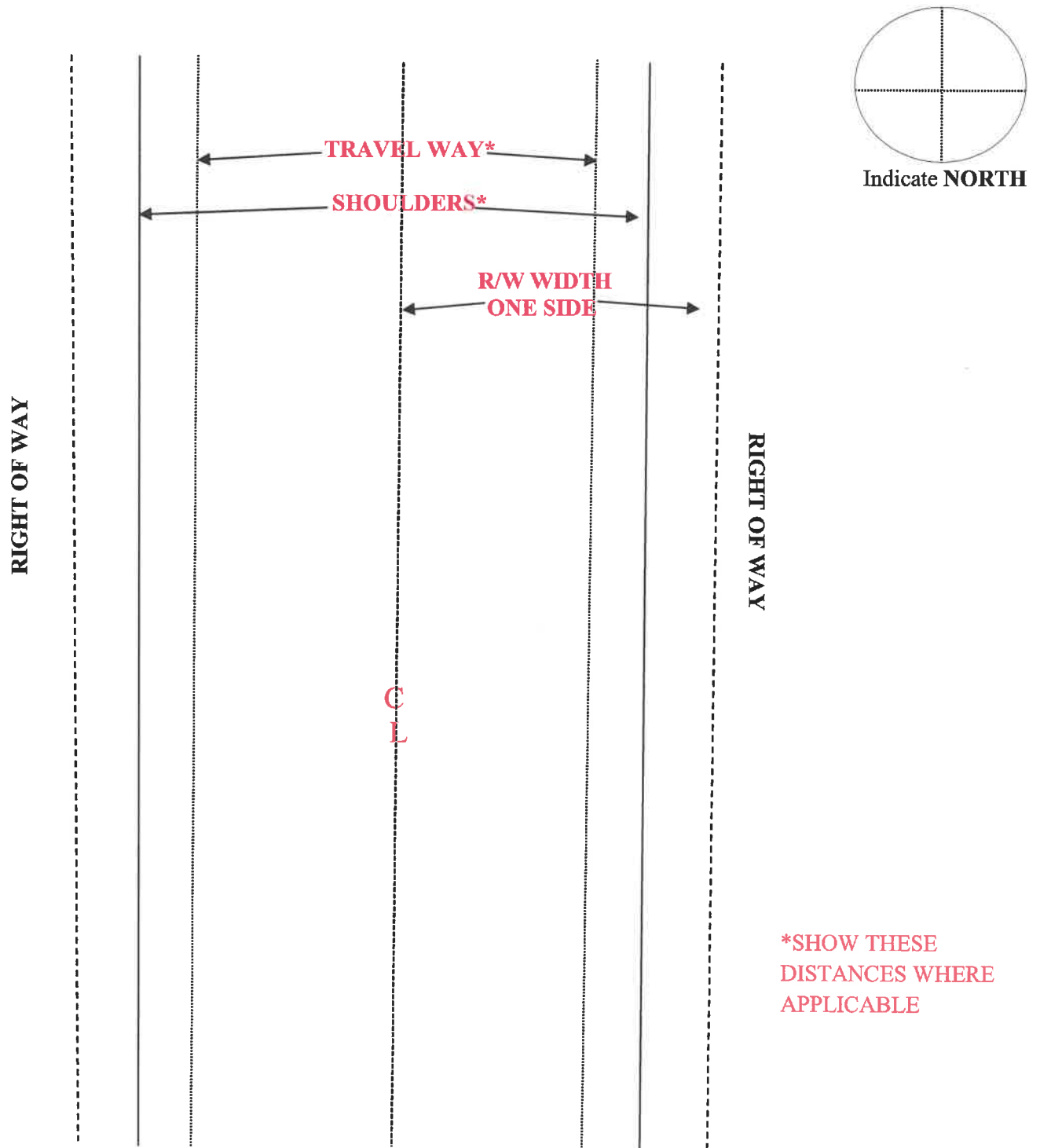
The applicant agrees to be responsible for all restoration of the affected area (including repaving) to the satisfaction of the Road Commissioner or their representative with 14 days of completion of work.
