M.R.S.A. Title 23 § 3360 requires:

1. A person to give a minimum of 48 hours notice, in writing, to utility companies or districts prior to excavating the highway, also when the opening is in a railroad right-of-way.
2. A person to file copies of all notices with the Town of Paris before any required permit is issued or certifies that such notices have been given.
3. Utility companies or districts must give written or verbal notice to other utility companies or districts prior to the excavation.
4. Your endorsement of this form certifies to the Town of Paris that utility companies and districts have been notified in accordance with the requirements listed above.
5. Proper signage and traffic control must be used to the satisfaction of the Road Commissioner or their authorized representative. Prior to back filling, the Highway Foreman will be notified.
6. All back fill will be of appropriate material and compacted in 12" layers/lifts.
7. All excavations will be properly and completely repaired in 7 working days from time of back filling.
8. Applicant is responsible for excavation until it is repaved.

STATEMENT OF AGREEMENT

I UNDERSTAND THAT THE OPENING WILL BE MEASURED BY THE ROAD COMMISSIONER OR THEIR REPRESENTATIVE AND REVIEWED BY THE CEO. I AGREE TO PAY ANY SUBSEQUENT CHARGES ON THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THOSE ESTIMATED AND THE ACCURATE MEASUREMENTS. IF TOTAL COSTS ARE FOUND TO BE LESS THAN ESTIMATED FEE PAID, A REFUND WILL BE MADE. (only refunds in excess of \$1.00 will be made.) I AGREE TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL RESTORATION OF THE AFFECTED AREA (INCLUDING REPAVING) TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE ROAD COMMISSIONER OR THEIR REPRESENTATIVE WITHIN 14 DAYS OF COMPLETION OF WORK.
